## Monster Dance BOW Quilt 4x4 5x5 6x6 7x7 and 8x8 Instructions

### BLOCK 12 – WITCH

This block of the week quilt will consist of 16 blocks over 10 weeks. The quilt will also include borders. The plan for the quilt is as follows:

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

### 4x4 (10cm x 10cm) Hoop

#### **BLOCK 12 - WITCH**

**Fabric A** - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6") background 1  
**Fabric B** - 12cm x 12cm (4.5" x 4.5") background 2  
**Fabric C** - 8cm x 6.5cm (3" x 2.5") background 3  
**Fabric D** - 2.5cm x 2.5cm (1" x 1") face  
**Fabric E** - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") legs  
**Fabric F** - 8cm x 8cm (3" x 3") sleeves and skirts  
**Fabric G** - 2.5cm x 4cm (1" x 1.5") top

**Batting 1** - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6")

### 5x5 (13cm x 13cm) Hoop

#### **BLOCK 12 - WITCH**

**Fabric A** - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background 1  
**Fabric B** - 14cm x 14cm (5.5" x 5.5") background 2  
**Fabric C** - 9cm x 8cm (3.5" x 3") background 3  
**Fabric D** - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") face  
**Fabric E** - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") legs  
**Fabric F** - 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4") sleeves and skirts  
**Fabric G** - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") top

**Batting 1** - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

### 6x6 (16cm x 16cm) Hoop and 150mm x 150mm Hoop

#### **BLOCK 12 - WITCH**

**Fabric A** - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") background 1  
**Fabric B** - 17cm x 17cm (6.5" x 6.5") background 2  
**Fabric C** - 12cm x 10cm (4.5" x 4") background 3  
**Fabric D** - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") face  
**Fabric E** - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") legs  
**Fabric F** - 12cm x 12cm (4.5" x 4.5") sleeves and skirts  
**Fabric G** - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") top

**Batting 1** - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

### 7x7 (18cm x 18cm) Hoop

#### **BLOCK 12 - WITCH**

**Fabric A** - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") background 1  
**Fabric B** - 19cm x 19cm (7.5" x 7.5") background 2  
**Fabric C** - 13cm x 12cm (5" x 4.5") background 3  
**Fabric D** - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") face  
**Fabric E** - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") legs  
**Fabric F** - 13cm x 13cm (5" x 5") sleeves and skirts  
**Fabric G** - 5cm x 6.5cm (2" x 2.5") top

**Batting 1** - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

### 8x8 (20cm x 20cm) Hoop

#### **BLOCK 12 - WITCH**

**Fabric A** - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10") background 1  
**Fabric B** - 22cm x 22cm (8.5" x 8.5") background 2  
**Fabric C** - 14cm x 13cm (5.5" x 5") background 3  
**Fabric D** - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") face  
**Fabric E** - 6.5cm x 6.5cm (2.5" x 2.5") legs  
**Fabric F** - 14cm x 14cm (5.5" x 5.5") sleeves and skirts  
**Fabric G** - 6.5cm x 6.5cm (2.5" x 2.5") top

**Batting 1** - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10")

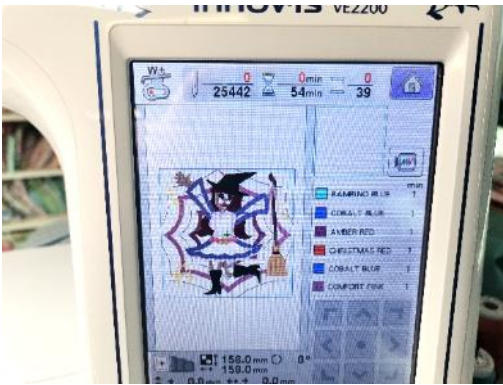
We will not be obligated to compensate customers who have put our files through their software and the resulting stitch-out was not as intended.

### BLOCK 12 - WITCH

Hoop up **cutaway stabiliser** in the hoop. Load design onto your machine. Use applique scissors for trimming the batting and fabric.



**STEP 1** Place **Batting 1** on top of the hoop. Stitch the batting down. Remove the hoop from your machine and trim the batting about 1-2mm from the stitching.



**STEP 2** Place **Fabric A** on top of the hoop right side up covering the batting. Stitch down.



Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric 1-2mm from the inner stitching only. Leave the excess fabric in the seams.



**STEP 3** Embroider the decorative stitch on background 1.



**STEP 4** Stitch the placement line for background 2.



**STEP 5** Place **Fabric B** on top of the hoop right side up covering the placement line. Stitch down.



Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric 1-2mm from the outer and inner stitching.



**STEPS 6 & 7** Embroider the decorative stitch on background 2, then embroider the satin stitch between background 1 and 2.



**STEPS 8 & 9** Repeat the applique process for background 3 using **Fabric C**. Trim.



**STEP 10** Embroider the satin stitch between background 2 and 3.



**STEP 11** Embroider the broom handle.



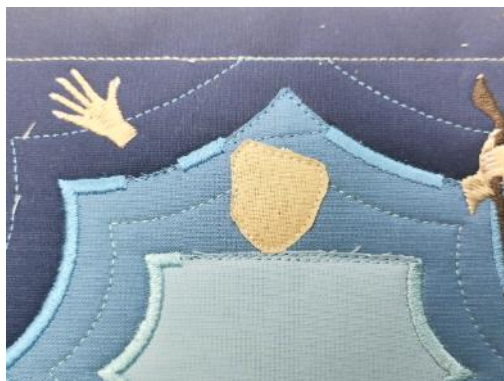
**STEPS 12 & 13** Embroider the broom head, then the cord at the top of the broom head.



**STEPS 14 & 15** Embroider the witch's hands, then her nails.



**STEPS 16 & 17** Repeat the applique process for the face using **Fabric D**. Trim.



**STEP 18** Embroider the first part of the witch's hair.



**STEPS 19 & 20** Embroider the whites of the eyes, then the pupils and eyelashes.



**STEPS 21 & 22** Embroider the eyebrows, then the lips.



**STEP 23** Embroider the nose, neck and satin stitch around the face.



**STEP 24** Embroider the rest of the witch's hair.



**STEP 25** Embroider the hat.



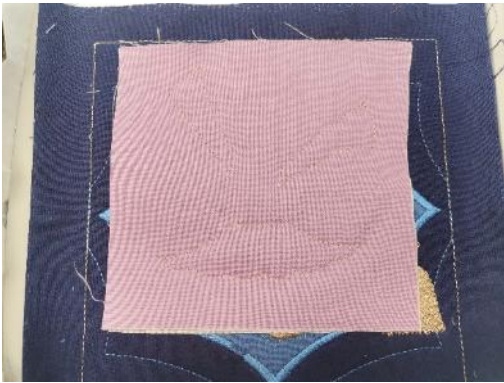
**STEPS 26 & 27** Repeat the applique process for the legs using **Fabric E**. Trim.



**STEP 28** Embroider the satin stitch around the legs.



**STEPS 29 & 30** Repeat the applique process for the sleeves and skirt using **Fabric F**. Trim.



**STEPS 31 & 32** Embroider the ruffle under the skirt, then embroider the satin stitch around the sleeves and skirt.



**STEPS 33 & 34** Repeat the applique process for the top using **Fabric G**. Trim.



**STEP 35** Embroider the satin stitch around the top.



**STEPS 36 & 37** Embroider the belt, then the belt buckle.



**STEP 38** Embroider the boots.



**OPTIONAL: STEP 39** Embroider the sparkles.



Remove your work from the hoop. Trim the seams to about ½ an inch.



Hold aside until next week.
