FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

4x4 (10cm x 10cm) Hoop

BLOCK 6 - WEREWOLF

Fabric A - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6") background

Fabric B - 9cm x 9cm (3.5" x 3.5") moon

Fabric C - 5cm x 4cm (2" x 1.5") speaker

Fabric D - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") tail

Fabric E - 6.5cm x 4cm (2.5" x 1.5") shirt

Fabric F - 8cm x 6.5cm (3" x 2.5") pants

Fabric G - 5cm x 4cm (2" x 1.5") vest

Fabric H - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") head

Batting 1 - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6")

5x5 (13cm x 13cm) Hoop

BLOCK 6 - WEREWOLF

Fabric A - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background

Fabric B - 12cm x 12cm (4.5" x 4.5") moon

Fabric C - 6.5cm x 5cm (2.5" x 2") speaker

Fabric D - 6.5cm x 6.5cm (2.5" x 2.5") tail

Fabric E - 9cm x 5cm (3.5" x 2") shirt

Fabric F - 9cm x 8cm (3.5" x 3") pants

8x8 (20cm x 20cm) Hoop

Fabric A - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10") background

Fabric B - 17cm x 17cm (6.5" x 6.5") moon

Fabric C - 10cm x 8cm (4" x 3") speaker

Fabric D - 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4") tail

Fabric E - 13cm x 9cm (5" x 3.5") shirt

Fabric F - 13cm x 12cm (5" x 4.5") pants

Fabric G - 10cm x 8cm (4" x 3") vest

Fabric H - 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4") head

Batting 1 - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10")

BLOCK 6 - WEREWOLF

Hoop up **cutaway stabiliser** in the hoop. Load design onto your machine. Use applique scissors for trimming the batting and fabric.



STEP 1 Place **Batting 1** on top of the hoop. Stitch the batting down. Remove the hoop from your machine and trim the batting about 1-2mm from the stitching.



STEP 2 Place **Fabric A** on top of the hoop right side up covering the batting. Stitch down. Do not trim.



STEP 3 Embroider the quilting onto the background



STEP 4 Stitch the placement line for the moon.



STEP 5 Place **Fabric B** on top of the hoop right side up covering the placement line. Stitch down.



Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric 1-2mm from the stitching.



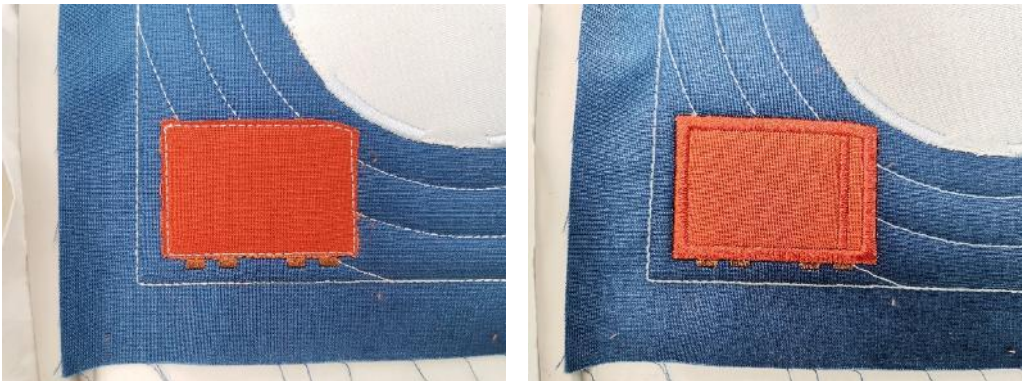
STEP 6 Embroider the satin stitch around the moon.



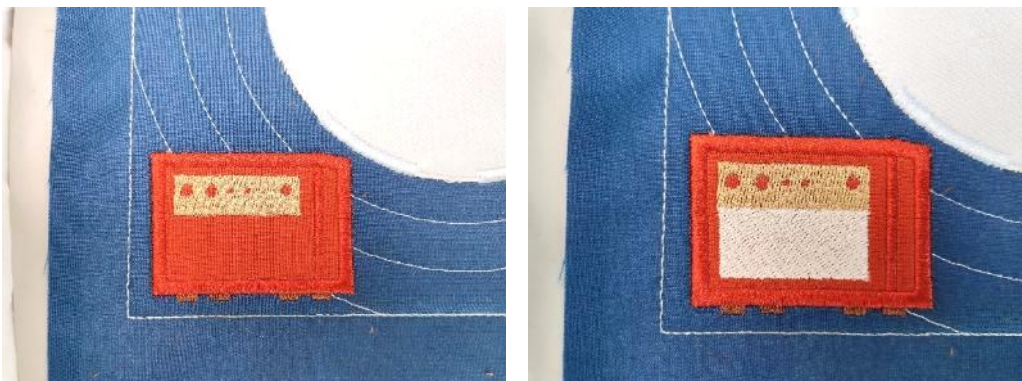
STEPS 7 & 8 Repeat the applique process for the speaker using **Fabric C**. Trim.



STEPS 9 & 10 Embroider the legs of the speaker, then embroider the satin stitch around the speaker.



STEPS 11 & 12 Embroider the top panel of the speaker, then the bottom panel.



STEP 13 Embroider the cross-stitch pattern and outline onto the speaker panels.



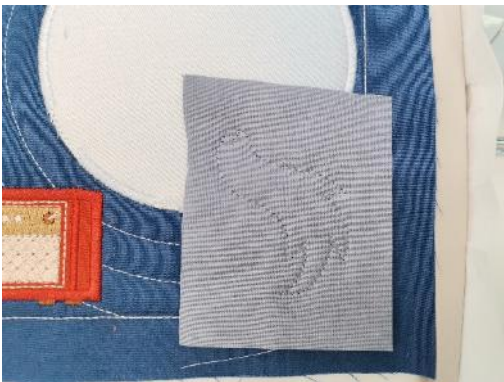
STEP 14 Embroider the decorative stitch around the speaker panels.



STEPS 15 & 16 Embroider the two colours of the buttons.



STEPS 17 - 19 Repeat the applique process for the tail using **Fabric D**. Trim, then embroider the satin stitch around the tail.



STEP 20 Embroider some of the werewolf's claws.



STEPS 21 & 22 Embroider the werewolf's arms and feet, then embroider the rest of the claws.



STEPS 23 - 25 Repeat the applique process for the shirt using **Fabric E**. Trim, then embroider the satin stitch around the shirt.



STEPS 26 - 28 Repeat the applique process for the pants using **Fabric F**. Trim, then embroider the satin stitch around the pants.



STEPS 29 - 31 Repeat the applique process for the vest using **Fabric G**. Trim, then embroider the satin stitch around the vest.



STEPS 32 - 34 Repeat the applique process for the werewolf's head using **Fabric H**. Trim. Embroider the fur onto the werewolf's head.



STEP 35 Embroider the satin stitch around the head, then the eyebrow.



STEPS 36 & 37 Embroider the werewolf's nose and eye, then embroider the inner ear.



STEP 38 Embroider the decorative satin stitch (howl) next to the werewolf's mouth.



STEP 39 Embroider the music coming from the speaker.



OPTIONAL: STEP 40 Embroider the sparkles.



Remove your work from the hoop. Trim the seams to about ½ an inch.



Hold aside until next week.
