BLOCK 7 – VAMPIRE

This block of the week quilt will consist of 16 blocks over 10 weeks. The quilt will also include borders. The plan for the quilt is as follows:

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

4x4 (10cm x 10cm) Hoop

BLOCK 7 - VAMPIRE

Fabric A - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6") background 1

Fabric B - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6") background 2

Fabric C - 9cm x 6.5cm (3.5" x 2.5") cape

Fabric D - 8cm x 8cm (3" x 3") pants

Fabric E - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") shirt

Fabric F - 9cm x 8cm (3.5" x 3") coat

Fabric G - 2.5cm x 2.5cm (1" x 1") face

Batting 1 - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6")

5x5 (13cm x 13cm) Hoop

BLOCK 7 – VAMPIRE

Fabric A - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background 1

Fabric B - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background 2

Fabric C - 10cm x 9cm (4" x 3.5") cape

Fabric D - 9cm x 9cm (3.5" x 3.5") pants

Fabric E - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") shirt

Fabric F - 12cm x 9cm (4.5" x 3.5") coat

Fabric G - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") face

Batting 1 - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

6x6 (16cm x 16cm) Hoop and 150mm x 150mm Hoop

Fabric A - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") background 1

Fabric B - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") background 2

Fabric C - 13cm x 10cm (5" x 4") cape

Fabric D - 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4") pants

Fabric E - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") shirt

Fabric F - 13cm x 10cm (5.5" x 4") coat

Fabric G - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") face

Batting 1 - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

7x7 (18cm x 18cm) Hoop

Fabric A - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") background 1

Fabric B - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") background 2

Fabric C - 14cm x 12cm (5.5" x 4.5") cape

Fabric D - 12cm x 12cm (4.5" x 4.5") pants

Fabric E - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") shirt

Fabric F - 15cm x 12cm (6" x 4.5") coat

Fabric G - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") face

Batting 1 - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

8x8 (20cm x 20cm) Hoop

Fabric A - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10") background 1

Fabric B - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10") background 2

Fabric C - 15cm x 13cm (6" x 5") cape

Fabric D - 13cm x 13cm (5" x 5") pants

Fabric E - 6.5cm x 6.5cm (2.5" x 2.5") shirt

Fabric F - 17cm x 13cm (6.5" x 5") coat

Fabric G - 6.5cm x 6.5cm (2.5" x 2.5") face

Batting 1 - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10")

BLOCK 7 - VAMPIRE

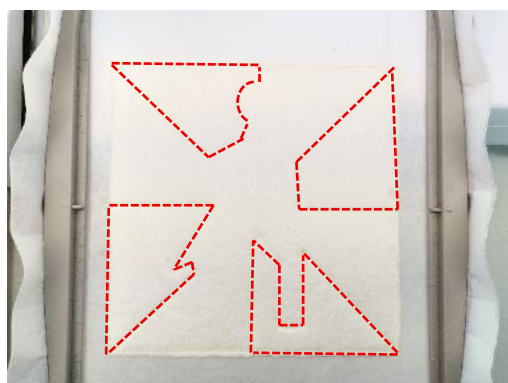
Hoop up **cutaway stabiliser** in the hoop. Load design onto your machine. Use applique scissors for trimming the batting and fabric.



STEP 1 Place **Batting 1** on top of the hoop. Stitch the batting down. Remove the hoop from your machine and trim the batting about 1-2mm from the stitching.



STEP 2 Stitch the placement line for background 1.



STEP 3 Place **Fabric A** on top of the hoop right side up covering the placement line. Stitch down.



Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric 1-2mm from the stitching.



STEPS 4 & 5 Repeat the applique process for background 2 using **Fabric B**. Trim, leaving the excess fabric in the seams.



STEPS 6 & 7 Embroider the two colours of satin stitches along the background fabrics.



STEPS 8 & 9 Repeat the applique process for the cape using **Fabric C**. Trim.



STEP 10 Embroider the satin stitch around the cape.



STEPS 11 & 12 Embroider the shoes, then the buckles on the shoes.



STEPS 13 & 14 Repeat the applique process for the pants using **Fabric D**. Trim.



STEP 15 Embroider the satin stitch around the pants.



STEPS 16 & 17 Embroider the hands, then the nails.



STEPS 18 & 19 Repeat the applique process for the shirt using **Fabric E**. Trim.



STEPS 20 & 21 Repeat the applique process for the coat using **Fabric F**. Trim.



STEP 22 Embroider the satin stitch around the coat.



STEP 23 Embroider the buttons on the shirt.



STEPS 24 & 25 Embroider the cape collar, then the button on the cape collar.



STEPS 26 & 27 Repeat the applique process for the face using **Fabric G**. Trim.



STEP 28 Embroider the right ear and satin stitch around the face.



STEP 29 Embroider the hair.



STEPS 30 & 31 Embroider the outer left ear and nose, then embroider the inner left ear.



STEP 32 Embroider the eyebrows, eyes and mouth.



STEP 33 Embroider the shine on the right eye, then the teeth.



STEP 34 Embroider the bats.



OPTIONAL: STEP 35 Embroider the sparkles.



Remove your work from the hoop. Trim the seams to about ½ an inch.



Hold aside until next week.
