BLOCK 15 – FRANKENSTEIN’S BRIDE

This block of the week quilt will consist of 16 blocks over 10 weeks. The quilt will also include borders. The plan for the quilt is as follows:

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

4x4 (10cm x 10cm) Hoop

BLOCK 15 – FRANKENSTEIN'S BRIDE

Fabric A - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6") background 1

Fabric B - 12cm x 13cm (4.5" x 5") background 2

Fabric C - 6.5cm x 5cm (2.5" x 2") background 3 (alternatively you can use excess fabric trimmed from background 1)

Fabric D - 8cm x 6.5cm (3" x 2.5") face and arms

Fabric E - 8cm x 9cm (3" x 3.5") dress

Fabric F - 5cm x 4cm (2" x 1.5") hair

Batting 1 - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6")

5x5 (13cm x 13cm) Hoop

BLOCK 15 – FRANKENSTEIN'S BRIDE

Fabric A - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background 1

Fabric B - 14cm x 15cm (5.5" x 6") background 2

Fabric C - 8cm x 6.5cm (3" x 2.5") background 3 (alternatively you can use excess fabric trimmed from background 1)

Fabric D - 9cm x 8cm (3.5" x 3") face and arms

Fabric E - 9cm x 10cm (3.5" x 4") dress

Fabric F - 8cm x 5cm (3" x 2") hair

Batting 1 - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

6x6 (16cm x 16cm) Hoop and 150mm x 150mm Hoop

BLOCK 15 – FRANKENSTEIN'S BRIDE

Fabric A - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") background 1

Fabric B - 17cm x 18cm (6.5" x 7") background 2

Fabric C - 9cm x 8cm (3.5" x 3") background 3 (alternatively you can use excess fabric trimmed from background 1)

Fabric D - 10cm x 9cm (4" x 3.5") face and arms

Fabric E - 12cm x 13cm (4.5" x 5") dress

Fabric F - 9cm x 6.5cm (3.5" x 2.5") hair

Batting 1 - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

7x7 (18cm x 18cm) Hoop

BLOCK 15 – FRANKENSTEIN'S BRIDE

Fabric A - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") background 1

Fabric B - 18cm x 20cm (7" x 8") background 2

Fabric C - 10cm x 8cm (4" x 3") background 3 (alternatively you can use excess fabric trimmed from background 1)

Fabric D - 12cm x 10cm (4.5" x 4") face and arms

Fabric E - 12cm x 14cm (4.5" x 5.5") dress

Fabric F - 9cm x 6.5cm (3.5" x 2.5") hair

Batting 1 - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

8x8 (20cm x 20cm) Hoop

BLOCK 15 – FRANKENSTEIN'S BRIDE

Fabric A - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10") background 1

Fabric B - 20cm x 23cm (8" x 9") background 2

Fabric C - 12cm x 9cm (4.5" x 3.5") background 3 (alternatively you can use excess fabric trimmed from background 1)

Fabric D - 13cm x 12cm (5" x 4.5") face and arms

Fabric E - 13cm x 15cm (5" x 6") dress

Fabric F - 10cm x 8cm (4" x 3") hair

Batting 1 - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10")

BLOCK 15 – FRANKENSTEIN'S BRIDE

Hoop up **cutaway stabiliser** in the hoop. Load design onto your machine. Use applique scissors for trimming the batting and fabric.



STEP 1 Place **Batting 1** on top of the hoop. Stitch the batting down. Remove the hoop from your machine and trim the batting about 1-2mm from the stitching.



STEP 2 Stitch the placement line for background 1.



STEP 3 Place **Fabric A** on top of the hoop right side up covering the placement line. Stitch down.



Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric 1-2mm from the stitching. Leave the excess fabric in the seams.



STEP 4 Embroider the quilting onto background 1.



STEPS 5 & 6 Repeat the applique process for background 2 using **Fabric B**. Trim, leaving the excess fabric in the seams.



STEP 7 Embroider the quilting onto background 2.



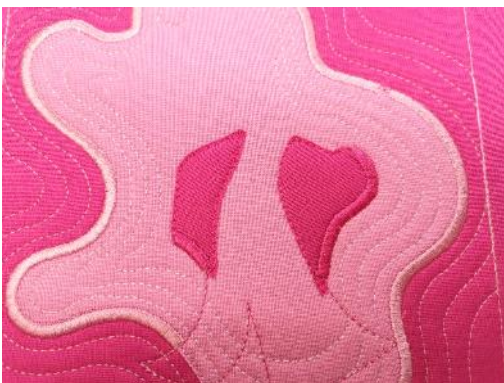
STEP 8 Embroider the satin stitch around background 2



STEPS 9 & 10 Repeat the applique process for background 3 using **Fabric C**. Trim.



STEP 11 Embroider the satin stitch around background 3



STEPS 12 & 13 Embroider the hand on the right, then embroider the hand on the left.



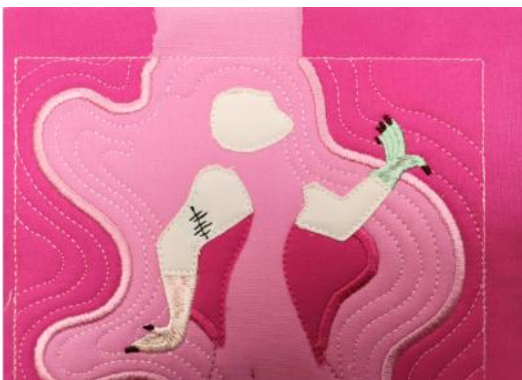
STEP 14 Embroider the nails.



STEPS 15 & 16 Repeat the applique process for the face and arms using **Fabric D**. Trim.



STEP 17 Embroider the stitches on the arm on the left.



STEP 18 Embroider the satin stitches on the arms/face and embroider the neck and legs.



STEPS 19 & 20 Embroider the stitches for the hand on the right, then embroider the stitches for the hand on the left.



STEPS 21 & 22 Embroider the base of the shoes, then embroider the shoes.



STEP 23 Embroider the shoelaces.



STEPS 24 & 25 Repeat the applique process for the dress using **Fabric E**. Trim.



STEP 26 Embroider the frills on the arms and the bottom of the dress.



STEPS 27 & 28 Embroider the colours of patches on the dress.



STEP 29 Embroider the satin stitch around the dress.



STEPS 30 & 31 Repeat the applique process for the hair using **Fabric F**. Trim.



STEPS 32 & 33 Embroider the quilting onto the hair, then embroider the satin stitch around the hair and the eyebrow.



OPTIONAL: STEP 34 Embroider the star clip onto the hair.



STEP 35 Embroider the stitches on the face.



STEP 36 Embroider the lips.



STEPS 37 & 38 Embroider the eyeshadow, then embroider the eye.



STEPS 39 & 40 Embroider the inner ear, then the outer ear.



STEP 41 Embroider the earring.



OPTIONAL: STEP 42 Embroider the sparkles.



Remove your work from the hoop. Trim the seams to about ½ an inch.



Hold aside until next week.
