FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

4x4 (10cm x 10cm) Hoop

BLOCK 9 - FRANKENSTEIN'S MONSTER

Fabric A - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6") outer background

Fabric B - 13cm x 13cm (5" x 5") centre background

Fabric C - 2.5cm x 2.5cm (1" x 1") face

Fabric D - 8cm x 6.5cm (3" x 2.5") pants

Fabric E - 2.5cm x 5cm (1" x 2") shirt

Fabric F - 9cm x 5cm (3.5" x 2") coat

Batting 1 - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6")

5x5 (13cm x 13cm) Hoop

BLOCK 9 - FRANKENSTEIN'S MONSTER

Fabric A - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") outer background

Fabric B - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6") centre background

Fabric C - 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") face

Fabric D - 9cm x 8cm (3.5" x 3") pants

Fabric E - 2.5cm x 5cm (1" x 2") shirt

Fabric F - 12cm x 6.5cm (4.5" x 2.5") coat

Batting 1 - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

6x6 (16cm x 16cm) Hoop and 150mm x 150mm Hoop

Fabric A - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") outer background

Fabric B - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") centre background

Fabric C - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") face

Fabric D - 12cm x 9cm (4.5" x 3.5") pants

Fabric E - 4cm x 6.5cm (1.5" x 2.5") shirt

Fabric F - 13cm x 8cm (5" x 3") coat

Batting 1 - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

7x7 (18cm x 18cm) Hoop

Fabric A - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") outer background

Fabric B - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") centre background

Fabric C - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") face

Fabric D - 13cm x 10cm (5" x 4") pants

Fabric E - 4cm x 8cm (1.5" x 3") shirt

Fabric F - 14cm x 8cm (5.5" x 3") coat

Batting 1 - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

8x8 (20cm x 20cm) Hoop

Fabric A - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10") outer background

Fabric B - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") centre background

Fabric C - 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") face

Fabric D - 14cm x 12cm (5.5" x 4.5") pants

Fabric E - 4cm x 8cm (1.5" x 3") shirt

Fabric F - 17cm x 9cm (6.5" x 3.5") coat

Batting 1 - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10")

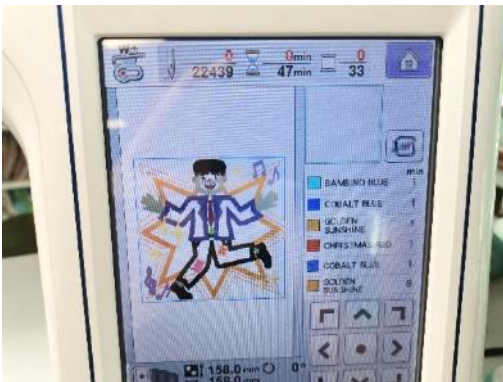
We will not be obligated to compensate customers who have put our files through their software and the resulting stitch-out was not as intended.

BLOCK 9 - FRANKENSTEIN'S MONSTER

Hoop up **cutaway stabiliser** in the hoop. Load design onto your machine. Use applique scissors for trimming the batting and fabric.



STEP 1 Place **Batting 1** on top of the hoop. Stitch the batting down. Remove the hoop from your machine and trim the batting about 1-2mm from the stitching.



STEP 2 Place **Fabric A** on top of the hoop right side up. Stitch down.



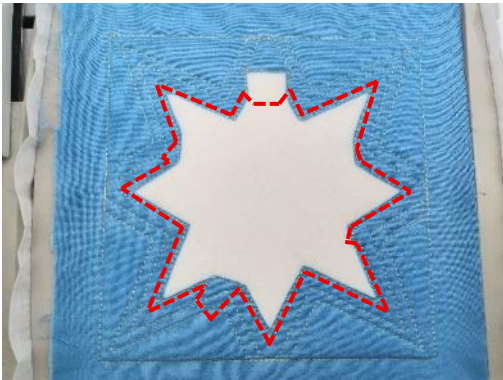
Remove the hoop from the machine and (optionally) trim the fabric 1-2mm from the inner stitching only. Leave the excess fabric in the seams.



STEP 3 Embroider the echo star quilting



STEP 4 Stitch the placement line for the inner background.



STEP 5 Place **Fabric B** on top of the hoop right side up covering the placement line. Stitch down.

Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric 1-2mm from the stitching.



STEP 6 Embroider the satin stitch around the inner background.



STEPS 7 & 8 Repeat the applique process for the face using **Fabric C**. Trim.



STEP 9 Embroider the stitches onto Frankenstein's face.



STEP 10 Embroider the hands, neck, feet and the satin stitch around the face.



STEP 11 Embroider the inner ears.



STEP 12 Embroider Frankenstein's hair.



STEPS 13 & 14 Repeat the applique process for the pants using **Fabric D**. Trim.



STEPS 15 & 16 Repeat the applique process for the shirt using **Fabric E**. Trim.



STEPS 17 & 18 Embroider the collar and centre of the shirt. Then embroider the necktie.



STEP 19 Embroider the satin stitch around the pants.



STEPS 20 & 21 Embroider the two patches onto the pants.



STEPS 22 & 23 Repeat the applique process for the coat using **Fabric F**. Trim.



STEPS 24 & 25 Embroider the lapels of the coat. Then the satin stitch around the coat.



STEPS 26 & 27 Embroider Frankenstein's eyebrows, eyes and mouth. Then embroider the shine onto the eyes.



STEPS 28 & 29 Embroider the nose, then the tongue.



STEPS 30 & 31 Embroider the shoes, then the soles and details of the shoes.



STEP 32 Embroider the musical notes.



OPTIONAL: STEP 33 Embroider the sparkles.



Remove your work from the hoop. Trim the seams to about ½ an inch.



Hold aside until next week.
