BLOCK 10 – MUMMY

This block of the week quilt will consist of 16 blocks over 10 weeks. The quilt will also include borders. The plan for the quilt is as follows:

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

4x4 (10cm x 10cm) Hoop

BLOCK 10 - MUMMY

Fabric A – 4cm x 6.5cm (1.5" x 2.5") **and** 4cm x 9cm (1.5" x 3.5") background 1

Fabric B - Cut 2 – 6.5cm x 15cm (2.5" x 6") background 2

Fabric C - 10cm x 15cm (4" x 6") background 3

Fabric D - 10cm x 12cm (4" x 4.5") mummy

Batting 1 - 15cm x 15cm (6" x 6")

5x5 (13cm x 13cm) Hoop

BLOCK 10 - MUMMY

Fabric A – 5cm x 8cm (2" x 3") **and** 5cm x 10cm (2" x 4") background 1

Fabric B - Cut 2 - 8cm x 18cm (3" x 7") background 2

Fabric C - 13cm x 18cm (5" x 7") background 3

Fabric D - 12cm x 14cm (4.5" x 5.5") mummy

Batting 1 - 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

6x6 (16cm x 16cm) Hoop and 150mm x 150mm Hoop

BLOCK 10 - MUMMY

Fabric A – 5cm x 12cm (2" x 3.5") **and** 5cm x 12cm (2" x 4.5") background 1

Fabric B - Cut 2 - 8cm x 20cm (3" x 8") background 2

Fabric C - 15cm x 20cm (6" x 8") background 3

Fabric D - 14cm x 17cm (5.5" x 6.5") mummy

Batting 1 - 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

7x7 (18cm x 18cm) Hoop

BLOCK 10 - MUMMY

Fabric A – 2.5cm x 10cm (2.5" x 4") **and** 6.5cm x 13cm (2.5" x 5") background 1

Fabric B - Cut 2 - 9cm x 23cm (3.5" x 9") background 2

Fabric C - 17cm x 23cm (6.5" x 9") background 3

Fabric D - 15cm x 18cm (6" x 7") mummy

Batting 1 - 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

8x8 (20cm x 20cm) Hoop

BLOCK 10 - MUMMY

Fabric A – 6.5cm x 12cm (2.5" x 4.5") **and** 6.5cm x 14cm (2.5" x 5.5") background 1

Fabric B - Cut 2 - 10cm x 25cm (4" x 10") background 2

Fabric C - 18cm x 25cm (7" x 10") background 3

Fabric D - 17cm x 20cm (6.5" x 8") mummy

Batting 1 - 25cm x 25cm (10" x 10")

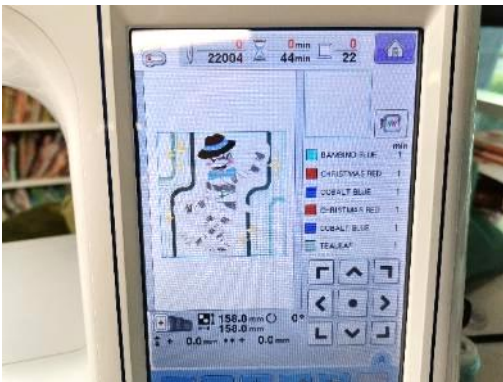
We will not be obligated to compensate customers who have put our files through their software and the resulting stitch-out was not as intended.

INSTRUCTIONS - USING YOUR EMBROIDERY MACHINE:

BLOCK 10 - MUMMY

Hoop up **cutaway stabiliser** in the hoop. Load design onto your machine. Use applique scissors for trimming the batting and fabric.



STEP 1 Place **Batting 1** on top of the hoop. Stitch the batting down. Remove the hoop from your machine and trim the batting about 1-2mm from the stitching.



STEP 2 Stitch the placement lines for the background 1.



STEP 3 Place **Fabric A** on top of the hoop right side up covering the placement lines. Stitch down.



Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric 1-2mm from the inner stitching only. Leave the excess fabric in the seams.



STEPS 4 & 5 Repeat the applique process for background 2 using **Fabric B**. Trim, leaving the excess fabric in the seams.



STEPS 6 & 7 Embroider the quilting onto background 2, then embroider the satin stitch between background 1 and 2.



STEPS 8 & 9 Repeat the applique process for background 3 using **Fabric C**. Trim, leaving the excess fabric in the seams.



STEP 10 Embroider the satin stitch along background 3.



STEPS 11 & 12 Repeat the applique process for the mummy using **Fabric D**. Trim.



STEP 13 Embroider the quilting of the cloth onto the mummy.



STEP 14 Embroider the excess cloth and satin stitch around the mummy.



STEPS 15 & 16 Embroider the hat, then the band of the hat.



STEP 17 Embroider the bow tie.



STEPS 18 & 19 Embroider the eyes and mouth, then embroider the shines onto the eyes.



STEP 20 Embroider the tongue.



OPTIONAL: STEP 21 Embroider the cheeks.



OPTIONAL: STEP 22 Embroider the sparkles.



Remove your work from the hoop. Trim the seams to about ½ an inch.



Hold aside until next week.
